Unfortunately, our 4th of July Parade on July 4, 2020 is canceled due to COVID-19

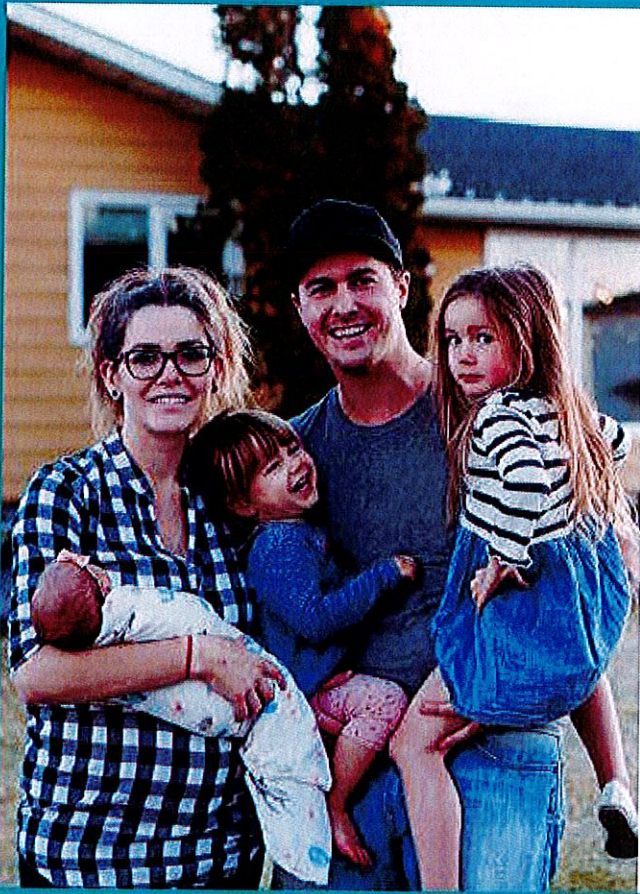

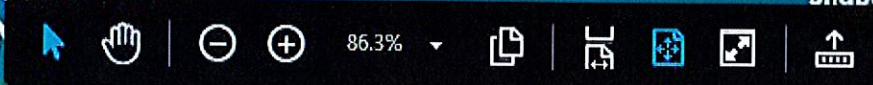
