

The Child Passenger Safety Grant for Low Income Families has been restored

Sullivan County Public Health Services operates a Low Income Child Passenger Safety Program funded by a grant from the NYS Governor's Traffic Safety Committee (GTSC). These grants are awarded to improve highway safety and reduce deaths and serious injuries to Children due to automobile accidents.

Parent/Guardian must bring proof of low income status, such as valid Medicaid card, WIC ID, food Stamp Card. The Child, the Car Seat the child is currently using and the vehicle the car seat will be installed in.

A new, unused car seat will be provided to Low Income Sullivan County residents who qualify and make an appointment at our Car Seat Clinics which will be on September 24th

Appointment only.

A NYS certified technician will instruct the parent / guardian on the proper use and installation of the car seat specific to that child.
